### **Purpose:**

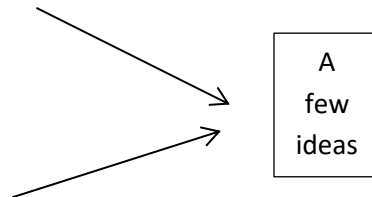
