Purpose:

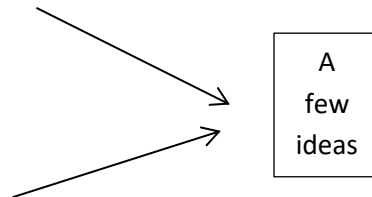

1. Kickball Tournament Fundraiser – Nathan

2. Request for Funds (Tickets for Choir for Rox Game/Taxi) – Nathan

Nathan will be requesting \$120-\$140 for ROX Tickets for choir members once he gets a number of students attending (Students sing National Anthem at Game). Request for \$90 for a taxi for a student for activities was granted. Nathan will be requesting Spring Scholarships to PAC after Spring Activities finish up, he is estimating about \$400.

3. Apparel Sales for Fall Ideas – Nathan

Zip-up jacket, hooded sweatshirt, winter hat, long sleeve T-shirt, long sleeve polo and T-shirt were chosen for the fall apparel order that will come out in early September.

4. New Topics

Chipotle will be used as a fundraiser again next year, Nathan working with the Somali Restaurant owners to set up a fundraiser through them for next year. Golf Tournament will be set up for early October – more info to come out later. Nathan will be working on recruiting new members this summer with the focus being on the parents in the younger grade levels. Discussion was had on ordering of new uniforms for the activities teams for next year to be paid for by PAC – Nathan will work on pricing for them. PAC will have someone at the open house to sell T-Shirts – all money collected on sales is profit as they have been paid for with prior sales.
